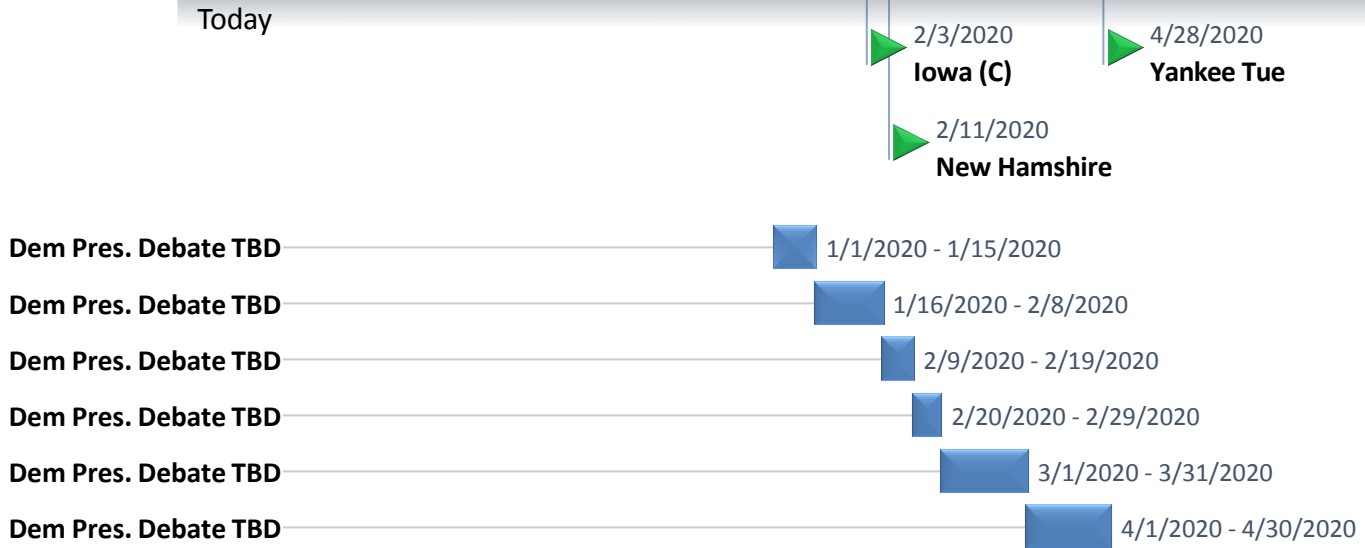
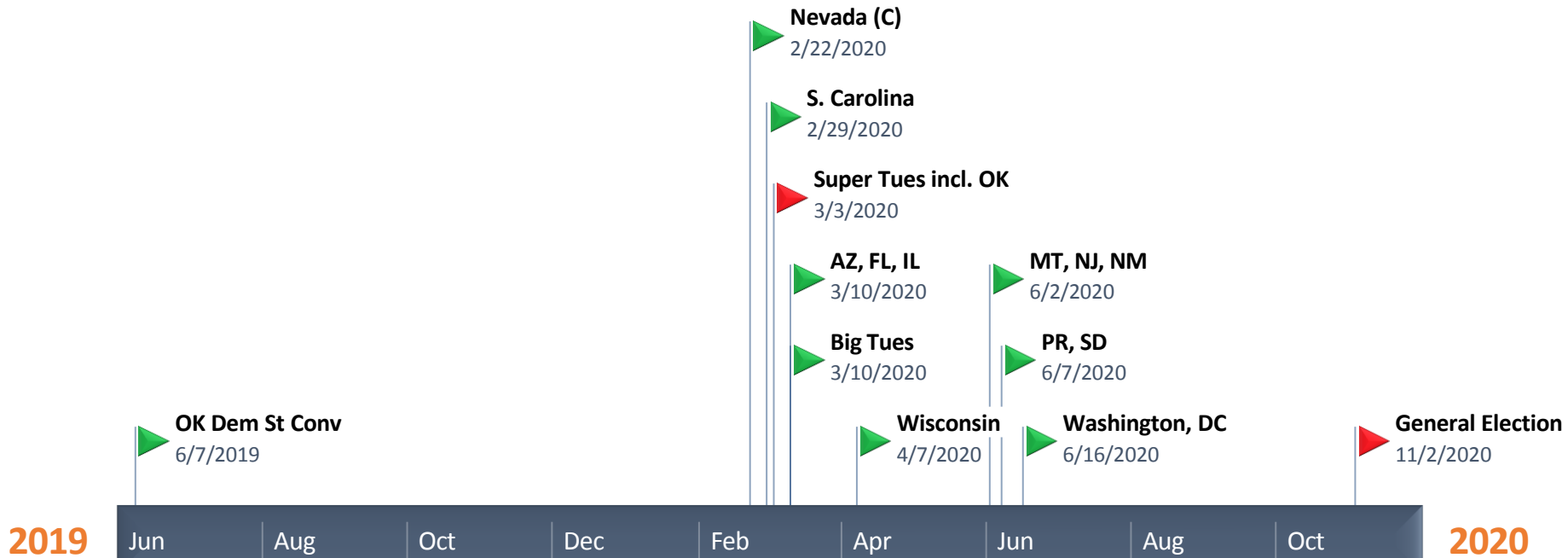

Appendix A: Page Annotations

Pg 1: Title Page where file name equals MS PowerPoint Name, Oklahoma County Democrats (Timelines) for Years 2019 & 2020

Pg 2: 2019 Election Dates. Milestones are indicated by pennant flags on the timeline. Yellow Pennants indicate the close of filing date for the following Election. Green Pennants indicate Voting date. Below the Timeline are tasks. Proposition Elections are indicated by Blue Task Bars. Candidate Elections are indicated by the Red Task Bars. Dates following the task bars are the election deadlines first and election date second. Proposition deadlines are the last day for the resolution to be filed with the Election Board. Candidate deadlines are the last day to file for an election.

There are some particular rules for “Special Elections” of Candidates and their last day to file, 20 days prior to the Election date. The Political Body responsible for filling office vacancies establishes the election date according to statutes, except when called by The Governor to fill vacancies in The State Legislature.

Pg 3: 2020 Election Dates. See explanation of 2019 Elections above. Special and Proposition Elections have been omitted for clarity but may be added as the year approaches.

December Elections are prohibited in even years.

Dates for Pg’s 2 & 3 were valid as of June 1, 2018, and are available from The State Election Board.

Pg. 4: OK Co. Democrats’ Tasks. Significant Milestones indicated by Green Pennants. As the OK Co. Central Committee defines or receives directives from CD5 and/or The State Party, tasks will be added. Current Tasks are:

- House District Committee vacancies to be filled. Percent complete to be added as data is available
- Precinct Officers vacancies to be filled. Percent complete to be added as data is available
- Precinct miniVAN completion. Percent complete to be added as data is available
- Medicare Expansion Ballot Petition signature collection. Beginning date assumed and end date 60 days thereafter. To be updated

Pg. 5 & 6: 2019 & 2020 Democratic Presidential Primary Dates and Debates. (A similar Timeline may produced for Oklahoma Elections) Milestones are significant State Presidential Primary Elections. Tasks are Democratic Presidential Primary Debates. To be updated as DNC finalizes dates and networks. Caucus States noted with (C). Common dates for multiple Sates are noted by ‘nicknames’. (see next page)
